BUDGET MEETING

The budget meeting began at 6:30 PM. Mrs. Donnelly's presentation can be found [HERE](#).

WORK MEETING

The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Mrs. Sheinin.

Ms. Shari Diamond from RS Abrams attended the meeting and reviewed the Treasurer's Report.

Mr. David Viegas provided an update on Health, Physical Education, and Athletics. He reviewed the levels of play in interscholastic athletics, COVID-19 impacts on sports, participation rates, and athletic achievements. Mr. Viegas also reviewed the new physical education standards and the topic covered in health courses. Questions were asked about integrating PAL and CYO into upcoming athletic programs and the District's high school athletes mentoring younger aspiring athletes. Mrs. Donnelly reviewed the budget status and revenue status reports.

Mrs. Donnelly reviewed resolutions regarding the District's corrective action plan management letter, the acceptance of the District's corrective action plan risk assessment, and the corrective action plan.

Mrs. Donnelly reviewed the General Cross Release regarding Stuart Marks, DDS.

Mrs. Donnelly reviewed the schedule of contracts, the schedule of bids, the transfers of appropriation, surplus equipment, the use of cellular phones and electronic equipment, and the applications for club charters.

Dr. Marino discussed the Nine-Period Day Task Force and the Princeton Plan Task Force. The task forces will run simultaneously. He reviewed the composition of the task forces, the objectives, and proposed timeline. A Board member asked why the union representatives were selected to serve on the Task Force. Another question was asked about task force facilitation. Dr. Marino will facilitate both task forces.

Dr. Marino reviewed the schedule for conferences and travel.

Dr. Marino discussed the addition of one teacher on the Professional Development Committee.

Dr. Marino discussed the policies for final approval: Policy #8131 Disaster Planning and Civil Preparedness, and Policy #2210 Board Organization Meeting.

Dr. Marino discussed the policies for initial review: Policy #1220 Relations with Community and Business Organizations for Abolishment, Policy #1000 Community Relations Goals Policy, and Policy #8130 School Safety Policy.
