Academic Intervention Services (AIS)

In past years, placement of students into AIS services was determined based largely upon performance on the NYSED assessments offered in Grades 3-8. Since those assessments were not widely taken last year, our process will remain the same for the 2021-2022 academic year.

1. Students who had been receiving services continue to be “grandfathered.”
2. We are using multiple measures to identify additional students who have developed gaps since last year’s placements into AIS services and to evaluate students who are new entrants into our schools.
