PTA ADVISORY COUNCIL

The Board of Education is committed to engaging with various stakeholders within the school community. To that end, the Board of Education shall, at its discretion, establish a PTA Advisory Council. The purpose of the council shall be to advise the Board of Education of issues of parental concern and provide updates on PTA activities. The council's purpose, structure and procedural operation is subject to review and modification by the Board.

PTA ADVISORY COUNCIL REGULATIONS

Procedure

1. The council shall be composed of parent/guardian representatives selected by the Central Council PTA through a procedure to be determined by the Central Council PTA. The Council will be chaired by a Co-President of the Association.
2. Meetings shall be held approximately four times each school year and shall be chaired by the President of the Board of Education or, in his/her absence, by his/her designee.
3. It is desirable to have a maximum number of Board members present although a committee of the Board may meet with the PTA Advisory Council.
4. Suggested agenda items shall be submitted to the Office of the Superintendent so that an agenda can be prepared and distributed prior to each meeting.
5. Public statements concerning the substance of discussions and/or operations of the PTA Advisory Council shall be made only by the Board following consultation and agreement with the PTA Central Council.
