TEACHER ADVISORY COUNCIL

The Board of Education is committed to engaging with various stakeholders within the school community. To that end, the Board of Education shall, at its discretion, establish a Teachers Advisory Council. The purpose of the council shall be to assist the Board in the communication and discussion of policy-level educational matters of professional concern. The council's purpose, structure and procedural operation is subject to review and modification by the Board.

TEACHER ADVISORY COUNCIL REGULATIONS

Procedure

1. The council shall be composed of faculty representatives selected by the Association through a procedure to be determined by the Association. The Council will be chaired by the First Vice President of the Association.
2. Meetings shall be held approximately four times each school year and shall be chaired by the President of the Board of Education or, in his/her absence, by his/her designee.
3. It is desirable to have a maximum number of Board members present although a committee of the Board may meet with the Teacher Advisory Council.
4. Meetings shall normally be held from 7:00 – 7:30 P.M.
5. Terms and conditions of employment will not be a subject for discussion.
6. Suggested agenda items shall be submitted to the Office of the Superintendent so that an agenda can be prepared and distributed prior to each meeting.
7. Public statements concerning the substance of discussions and/or operations of the Teacher Advisory Council shall be made only by the Board following consultation and agreement with the Association.
