

PRESCHOOL PROGRAMS FOR CHILDREN WITH DISABILITIES

The Board of Education recognizes its responsibility to see that students with disabilities residing in the district shall have the opportunity to participate in preschool programs as defined by Part 200 of the Commissioner's Regulations. The district will establish administrative practices and procedures to ensure that each child with a disability residing in the district has the opportunity to participate in preschool programs.

All district parents of preschool children will receive the request for evaluation of the preschool aged child. Appropriate administrative practices and procedures will be developed to ensure that parents receive and understand the request for evaluation.
